Our client services staff are skilled in offering a number of services to people living with HIV/AIDS (PHAs) as well as to those affected by HIV/AIDS – family, friends, loved ones.

All our services are **free and confidential**. Self referrals are encouraged.

Our main office is located in London. Support staff are available to meet with you outside regular office hours and at locations in any of the communities we serve within Perth, Huron, Lambton, Elgin, Middlesex, and Oxford Counties.

Our Services and Programs Include:

- Crisis intervention
- One-on-one sessions with a counsellor
